AFFIDAVIT OF EARL JONES

I, Earl Jones, being duly sworn, depose and say the following is true to the best of my recollection and belief and if called I am competent and willing to testify.

1. On August 30, 2017, at 1715 I was sitting at the dinner table in the chow hall with Jonathan Roden.

2. Roden finished his chicken patty and went to eat his banana when he realized worms were crawling out of the banana. Roden jumped back, showed me the worms/larva crawling, and immediately went to the sergeant's desk. (I could not hear the conversation).

3. The sergeant motioned for Roden to take the tray over to the food steward. (I could not hear this conversation).

4. Roden gave the banana to the food steward. Plont looked at the banana and put it back on Roden's tray. Roden gave the banana to Plont again. Plont rubbed his finger on the banana and gave the banana back. Roden took his ID card out of his pocket, put it on the cup rack, and turned to show the banana to Officer Templeton.

5. Plont finally took the banana, looked at it carefully, and nodded in agreement. Plont then yelled, "Take all those bananas off the line."

6. Raden was never loud, disrespectful, nor disruptive. The line did not stop until Food Steward Plont yelled, "Take all the bananas off of the line."
