**STIPULATION AND ORDER REGARDING
CASE CAPTION AND LIMITED PROTECTIVE ORDER**

The parties stipulate to the following terms, and the court adopts the stipulation, as follows:

1. Plaintiff originally filed this case in his own name. [Complaint, Ct Doc 1]
2. Due to the nature of the serious and stigmatizing criminal allegations against the Plaintiff, which (although he strongly denies them) by necessity he related in his Complaint, he seeks to proceed in this case pseudonymously, as “John Doe.”
3. Plaintiff filed an amended complaint [Ct Doc 3] replacing his actual name with this pseudonym.

4. Defendant does not object to Plaintiff's request to proceed under a pseudonym.

5. The case caption shall reflect "John Doe" as the name of the Plaintiff. All court filings shall use this pseudonym and Plaintiff's true name shall not be used, and/or be appropriately redacted. While Plaintiff's true name may be disclosed as necessary in discovery and investigation, the parties shall refrain from disclosing Plaintiff's true name publicly outside of litigation and discovery, "except as required by law, including the Freedom of Information Act."

6. The clerk of court shall accordingly change the caption of this case in court records to "John Doe" vs. Defendants, for purposes of online and other public searches of court records, including the ECF system and PACER.

7. The original complaint [Ct Doc 1] shall also be stricken and removed from the court file.
